### The Business Case (1)

- Users being able to easily program their own procedures was a major sales argument for Oracle Clinical
- Siebel Clinical allows significant customization, and leverages a significant developer community—again, a major lever

### The Business Case (2)

- This is the era where every program talks to everybody else
- Imagine the power of being able to leverage data from Oracle Clinical into signals for Study Managers, to be displayed in Siebel Clinical CTMS

## The Business Case (3)


- All Siebel systems implement business processes that eventually translate into money
- (Yeah, so does Oracle Clinical, but not as explicitly...)

 Interface to Oracle ERP, SAP, or equivalent, can imply live reconciliation of expense reports, site payments...

### The Business Case (4)

- Imagine the operational impact of being able to define business rules in one system, and have the result immediately written in the other system...
- And having all that power from the user seat, not having to develop custom code each time





Each rule incorporates a specific trigger



Invoicing happens upon accrual of revenue and is triggered by milestone achievement or monthly/quarterly, per contract








### Oracle Corporation AIA
